In addition, the **Deadwood Trolley** runs regular daily routes with stops at locations throughout town. Trolley schedules are available at the hotel front desk of The Lodge at Deadwood and at the entrances of most other Festival venues.

The fee for the trolley is \$2 per person per ride or one token per person per ride. Day passes are also available for \$5 per person. Tokens and day passes are available for purchase at select stops throughout Deadwood, including the Welcome Center, 501 Main St, and the History and Information Center, 3 Siever St.
